


Perfect continuous



Simple

I will become a Jedi, I promise

- A one-time event that happens in the future at some point





Continuous

We will be approaching the Cloud City shortly

- An ongoing event that will begin at some point in the future, with no indication of when it will end





Ed Sheeran (Perfect)

We will have eliminated all the Jedi through implementing Order 66 by the time the Chancellor has obtained emergency powers.

- An event that will be completed at some distant point in the future and it may have already started or it will start in the future. It needs a timeline by which the event will be completed.



Perfect continuous

We will have been training for a thousand years by the time we finally come across a Sith again.

- An ongoing event that has either already started or will start at some point in the future and is relevant for consideration at some further distant point in the future.
